DETERMINATION OF FEES

NO. 67 OF 1994

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Liquor Act 1975 governs the sale and consumption of liquor in the ACT.

Section 105A of the Act enables the Minister to determine fees for the purposes of the Act.

This Determination revokes Determination of Fees No. 76 of 1993 dated 22 June 1993 and published in the Australian Capital Territory Gazette No. S119 of 30 June 1993 and determines new fees for the purpose of the Act.

A statement of the old and new fees is hereunder.

The fees have generally been increased by 3% in line with the anticipated movement in 1994/95 of the Consumer Price Index. The Permit fee is not changed as it is to be the same as the business franchise fee payable under the Business Franchise (Liquor) Act 1993 which is to remain unchanged next financial year.
