EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Under Section 20 of the Boxing Control Act 1993 ('the Act'), the Minister may, by notice published in the Gazette, determine fees for the purposes of the Act.

This determination sets fees for application for approval to conduct a professional boxing contest, application for approval to conduct an amateur boxing contest and application for approval by a female to engage in a professional boxing contest.

The fees are based on the costs of administering the application and approval process, but also recognise affordability for amateur organisations. It is considered unreasonable to impose a charge on females seeking approval to participate in boxing contests as this provision does not apply to males.

The licences and fees are set out below. Charges have not previously been determined for these activities.

The fee for an application for approval to conduct a professional boxing contest is

\$80.00

The fee for an application for approval to conduct an amateur boxing contest is

\$20.00

The fee for an application by a female for approval to engage in a professional boxing contest is
