AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY RABBIT DESTRUCTION ACT 1919 REVOCATION AND DETERMINATION OF FEES

DETERMINATION No. 90 of 1994

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Rabbit Destruction Act 1919 governs the destruction and keeping of rabbits and noxious animals in the Australian Capital Territory. Under section 47A of the Rabbit Destruction Act 1919 the Minister may determine fees.

This Determination revokes the existing Determeination of Fees and sets fees for the grant of licences to keep live rabbits or hares. The fee payable for the grant of a rabbit licence has been reviewed and increased generally in line with the Consumer Price Index. The rabbit licence fee is \$6.00. The previous licence fee was \$5.70.
