LIQUOR ACT 1975

DETERMINATION OF FEES

NO. 160 OF 1994

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Liquor Act 1975 governs the sale and consumption of liquor in the ACT.

Section 105A of the Act enables the Minister to determine fees for the purposes of the Act.

This Determination revokes Determination of Fees No 67 of 1994 dated 22 June 1994 and published in the Australian Capital Territory Gazette No. S126 of 27 June 1993 and determines new fees for the purpose of the Act.

The determination incorporates new fees for the purpose of the issue of Proof of Age Cards and new fees for liquor permit applications to make them consistent with the liquor fees set pursuant to the Business Franchise (Liquor) Act 1993. The effect of the latter change is to remove the 7% liquor fee applying to low alcohol liquor. Other fees applicable under the Liquor Act remain unchanged.

Proof of Age Card	Not applicable	\$5 for persons aged between 18 and 25 and \$25 for persons aged 26 and over.
