Explanatory Statement

Poisons (Fees) Determination 2004 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2004—8

made under the

Poisons Act 1933, s 20 (Determination of fees)

The *Poisons Act 1933* regulates the control, sale and use of poisons and poisonous substances in the ACT.

Section 20 of the *Poisons Act 1933* provides the Minister with the power to determine fees for the Act.

This instrument revokes all previous determination of fees instruments and redetermines the fees for the Act. The instrument also provides that registered podiatrists under the *Podiatrists Act 1994* are exempt from the fee payable.

A determination under section 20 is a disallowable instrument.
