EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 87(1) of the ACT *Occupational Health and Safety Act 1989* provides that the Minister can approve codes of practice for the purpose of providing practical guidance to employers, self-employed persons and employees.

This Instrument is written pursuant to Section 87 of the Act.

The National Standard for Limiting Occupational Exposure to Ionizing Radiation – has been referred to the ACT Occupational Health and Safety Council in accordance with Section 87(2) of the ACT *Occupational Health and Safety Act 1989*. The ACT Occupational Health and Safety Council has recommended the adoption of the National Standard for Limiting Occupational Exposure to Ionizing Radiation – for application in the Australian Capital Territory.

The National Standard for Limiting Occupational Exposure to Ionizing Radiation applies to workplaces in which employees are occupationally exposed, or in which there is a potential for occupational exposure to ionizing radiation
