PUBLIC HEALTH (SALE OF FOOD AND DRUGS) REGULATIONS

NOTICE

Notice made in pursuance of the power conferred on the Minister of State for the Arts and Territories under regulation 13 of the Public Health (Sale of Food and Drugs) Regulations, and delegated under section 12C of the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910 to the General Manager of the Australian Capital Territory Community and Health Service.

1. The advertising or sale of:


- (a) *Solanum sodomaeum*, including all extracts or derivatives thereof in preparations for therapeutic use;
- (b) *Solanum dulcamara*, including all extracts or derivatives thereof in preparations for therapeutic use;
- (c) Solasodine for therapeutic use; and
- (d) Curaderm Cream

is prohibited.

2. This notice shall remain in force until varied or revoked by a subsequent notice.

3. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this notice is liable to a maximum penalty of \$1,500.
