All other copy is to be confined within the margins of: 20 mm from the top and bottom; and 25mm from left hand side and right hand side of the page. Copy is to be numbered consecutively and fastened securely together. Dates, proper names and signatures are to be shown clearly.

Copy will be returned unpublished if not submitted in accordance with these requirements.

CLOSING TIME. Notices for publication should be lodged at Public Affairs Branch, ACT Administration Centre, unless otherwise specified, by 4.30 pm, Wednesday in the week prior to publication.



- 8 that only part of the garage and the garden shed be used for the conduct of the business;
- 9 that the business will only be conducted on the land between the hours of 9.00 am and 6.00 pm Monday to Saturday;
- 10 that the Applicant will conduct the business strictly by appointment, and that such appointments will be organised to ensure that no more than one client is in attendance at any one time;

- 11 that this approval will terminate on the THIRTY FIRST day of MARCH 1991 or on such earlier date as the Minister determines in accordance with condition 12;
- 12 upon any failure to comply with any or all of the foregoing conditions the Minister or his Delegate under the said Act may give written notice requiring the Applicant to show cause within a period of fourteen days why this approval should not be revoked. At the expiration of this period the Minister or his Delegate may revoke the approval.



- 12 upon any failure to comply with any or all of the foregoing conditions the Minister or his Delegate under the said Act may give written notice requiring the Applicant to show cause within a period of fourteen days why this approval should not be revoked. At the expiration of this period the Minister or his Delegate may revoke the approval.


