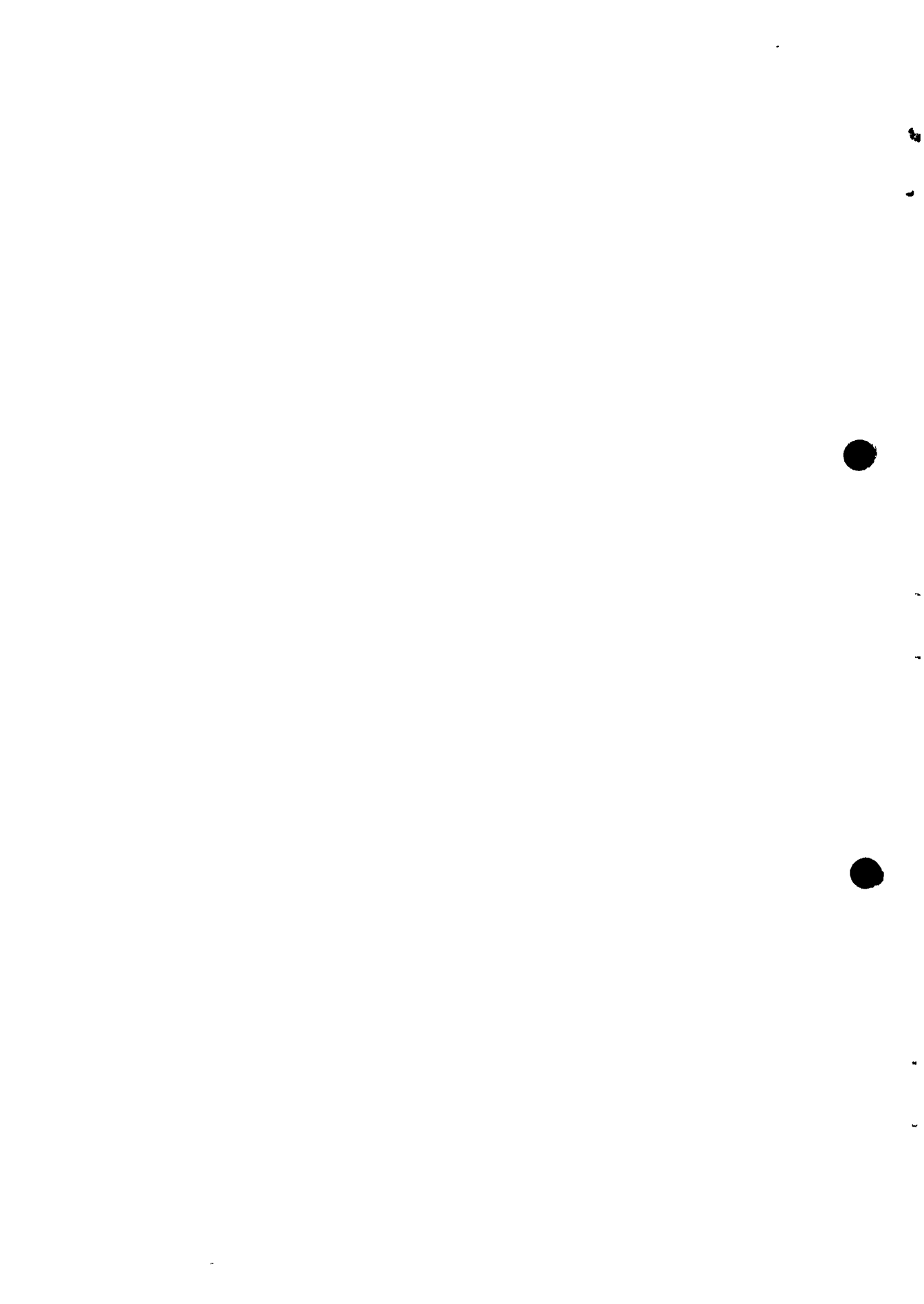





CITY AREA LEASES ACT 1936

INSTRUMENT OF APPROVAL UNDER SECTION 10

Under section 10 of the City Area Leases Act 1936 I DEBORAH LYNN BASSETT APPROVE of CLIVE WILLIAMS ("the Applicant") carrying on the profession trade occupation or calling of GALLERY DIRECTOR ("the business") on Block 3 Section 26 Division of FORREST known as 34 CANBERRA AVENUE FORREST ("the land") subject to the following conditions relating to the use of the land being observed by the Applicant in carrying on the business -

- 6 that the Applicant will ensure that all residence and business related vehicles are parked within the confines of the land;
- 7 that the Applicant will not employ any assistants for the purpose of conducting or carrying on the business on the land without the prior approval of the Minister;
- 8 that the business will only be conducted on the land between the hours of 10.00am and 5.00pm Saturdays and Sundays and public holidays;
- 9 that the Applicant will conduct the business strictly by appointment;
- 10 that this approval will terminate on the thirty-first day of May 1991 or on such earlier date as the Minister determines in accordance with condition 11;
- 11 upon any failure to comply with any or all of the foregoing conditions the Minister or his Delegate under the said Act may give written notice requiring the Applicant to show cause within a period of fourteen days why this approval should not be revoked. At the expiration of this period the Minister or his Delegate may revoke the approval.
