Definition of a person deemed to be a licensed travel agent

A 'deemed' travel agent is a person or company who has applied for a licence in accordance with the transitional arrangements for the introduction of licensing of travel agents in the ACT. Such an applicant is required to be a member of the Travel Compensation Fund, as are licensed travel agents.

Agents Registry

A person or company shall not carry on business as a travel agent unless they hold a travel agents licence, or are deemed to be licensed. The licencing authority in the ACT is the Agents Board of the ACT. Enquiries relating to the granting of travel agents licences and related matters should be directed to the Registrar of Agents, ACT Public Service, GPO Box 158, Canberra ACT 2601. (Phone 2462772).

Dealings with Unlicensed Travel Agents

It is an offence under section 71F(1) of the Act, for a person to provide a licenced travel agent with goods or services for disposal or authorises an unlicensed travel agent to dispose of rights to goods or services provided by the person.

In-Bound Tour Operators - Revocation of Exemption

The trust deed applying to the Travel Compensation Fund was amended on 15 July 1989 to provide Fund cover for clients of in-bound tour operators. It is intended that existing exemptions granted to in-bound tour operators in the ACT under Section 3(2) of the Agents Ordinance 1968 in respect of licencing requirements, will be revoked.

It therefore follows, that in-bound tour operators in the ACT are now required to become a member of the Travel Compensation Fund and hold a travel agents licence.







- 15 upon any failure to comply with any or all of the foregoing conditions the Minister or his Delegate under the said Act may give written notice requiring the Applicant to show cause within a period of fourteen days why this approval should not be revoked. At the expiration of this period the Minister or his Delegate may revoke the approval.
