EXEMPTION

NO.88 OF 1990

Under section 7A(6)(a) of the Motor Traffic Act 1936, I EXEMPT that class of motor vehicles, namely, heavy goods vehicles and heavy omnibuses manufactured between 1 January 1988 and 31 December 1990 from compliance with Australian Design Rule 65/00 for the period between 1 January 1991 and 31 March 1991.

### MOTOR TRAFFIC ACT 1936

#### EXEMPTION

#### NO.890F 1990

Under section 7A(6)(a) of the Motor Traffic Act 1936, I EXEMPT that class of motor vehicles, namely:-

- heavy goods vehicles manufactured from
   January 1988 receiving concessional registration
   for farm use
- 2. heavy goods vehicles and omnibuses manufactured from 1 January 1988 being driven to and from a Motor Vehicle Registry solely for the purpose of registration
- 3. heavy goods vehicles and heavy omnibuses manufactured from 1 January 1988 which do not travel a distance exceeding 80 kilometres from their normal base depot within the Australian Capital Territory

from compliance with Australian Design Rule 65/00.
