GAMING MACHINE ACT 1987

REVOCATION AND DECLARATION OF CLASS B GAMING MACHINES

Under section 4 of the <u>Gaming Machine Act 1987</u>, I REVOKE the Declaration of Class B <u>Gaming Machines made on 29 June 1987</u>, by the then Minister of State for Territories, gazetted in the Commonwealth Gazette Number S161 on 30 June 1987:

AND I DECLARE that the gaming machines which are commonly known as:

draw poker machines; five card poker machines; seven card stud poker machines; quarter horse racing machines; quinella machines; keno machines; or dwarf den machines

are class B gaming machines
