





CEMETERIES ACT

ORDER

IN PURSUANCE OF SECTION 18 OF THE CEMETERIES ACT 1933, I, CRAIG JOHN DUBY, Minister for Finance and Urban Services, HEREBY AMEND the original Order made by ROBERT JAMES ELLICOT, Minister of State for the Capital Territory, on the 23rd day of August 1979, to read as follows:

That after the 30th day of November 1979, burials in the Woden Cemetery, being unleased land belonging to the Territory dedicated to the purpose of a public cemetery by proclamation published in the Gazette on the 5th day of April 1934, shall be discontinued, excepting where the exclusive right of burial in a specified allotment has been granted in pursuance of Section 11 of that Act or for the purpose of an additional burial in pursuance of Regulation 22 of the Canberra Public Cemetery Regulations or for the purpose of interment of cremated remains.

# PURCHASING AND DISPOSALS

## Categories used in this Gazette
