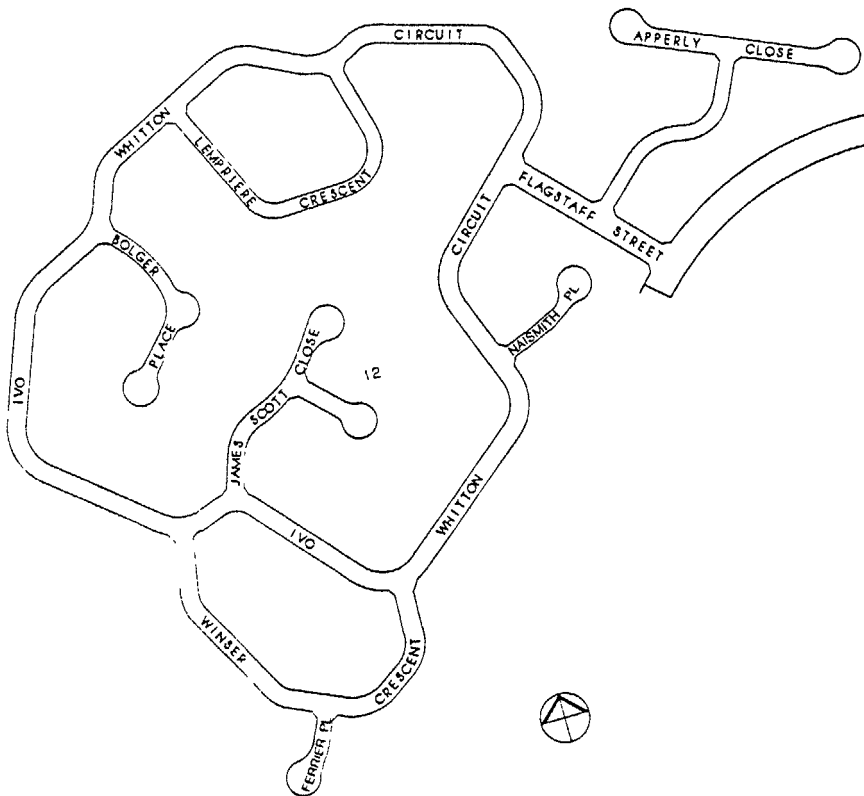
DIVISION OF MONASH
