## Explanatory Notes

- 1 Care should be taken in interpreting the quarterly figures on a strict pro-rata basis as fluctuations in the timing of payments can affect such an assessment.
- 2 Public Account receipts and expenditure are not simply the sum of Consolidated and Trust Funds receipts and expenditure respectively. The Public Account totals exclude transfers between the two Funds which would overstate the level of transactions of the Public Account.

- 3 Other financing transactions includes the following:
  - . \$81.6m carried forward from 1989/90 to finance expenditure to be incurred in 1990/91.
  - . An advance of \$2.8m to the ACT Housing Trust to assist in the financing of the redevelopment of Melba Flats.
  - . Application of the balance of funds in the Community Development Fund upon closure on 1 January 1991 (\$5.1m).
  - . Application of the balance of the Trust Fund as at 30 June 1990 (\$30.9m).
  - . \$2.6m transferred into the ACT Borrowing and Investment Trust Account (ACTBIT) on closure of the Loans Trust Account and Loans Redemption Trust Account on 1 September 1990.
  - . Borrowings of \$49.2m to be made through ACTBIT for payment to the Consolidated Fund.
