Invitation to Comment

The ACT Planning Authority is inviting comment on Land Use Policy changes for the sites of the Capital Park Royal Hotel (Block 6) and the National Convention Centre (Block 13).

The changes to the Planning Policies for these blocks will enable:

- 1. Part of the National Convention Centre to be used as the interim site for a Casino; and
- Development of a permanent Casino to be carried out on part of the existing site of the Capital Park Royal Hotel.

The land to be used for the Casino is to become a seperate lease.

Copies of the draft Variation may be inspected or obtained free of charge from the office of the ACT Planning Authority and the Shopfront at John Overall Offices, 220 Northbourne Avenue, Braddon during normal office hours from Monday 16 December 1991 to Friday 20 March 1992.
