

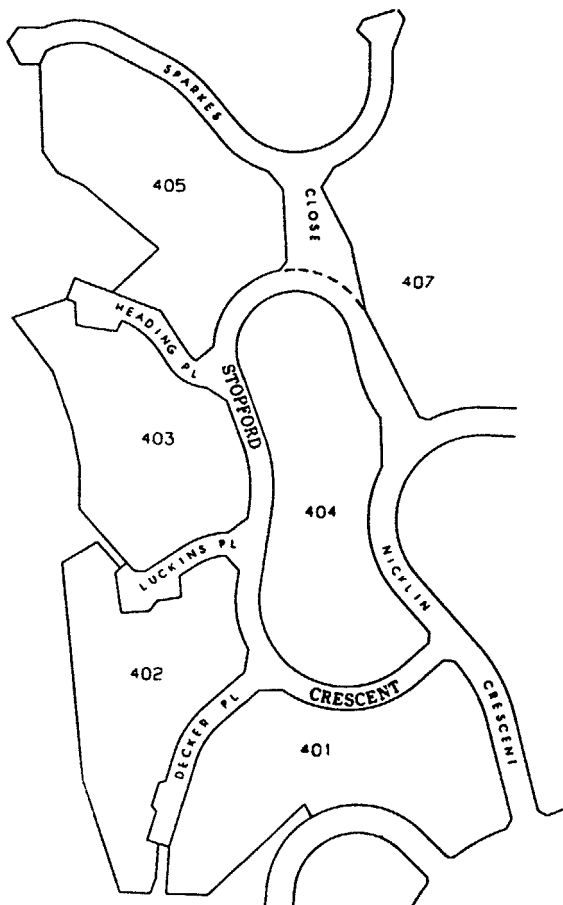

ADDITIONAL STREET NAME WITH REFERENCE TO ORIGIN

NAME:	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE/REMARKS
DIVISION OF FADDEN	THEME:	Queensland Politicians
STOPFORD CRESCENT	James STOPFORD (1878-1936)	Queensland Politician and Trade Unionist. Fitzroy Delegate to the 1910 Labor-in-Politics convention. Won Labor seat of Mount Morgan in the Legislative Assembly in 1915. From 1932 to his death held Maryborough. Parliamentary career also included Chairman (1918) to the Public Works Committee; Home Secretary in 1923-29; and Secretary for Mines 1932-36.
