
Nature Conservation Act 1980



NATURE CONSERVATION ACT 1980
DECLARATION

UNDER Section 16 of the Nature Conservation Act 1980 I DECLARE that the members of a species of wildlife listed in the Schedules to have special protection status.

I SPECIFY that in relation to the members of a species of wildlife :

- (a) specified in Schedule 5 that the grounds for making this declaration are that the protection of that species is part of the object of agreements between the Commonwealth and Japan and the People's Republic of China namely "Agreement Between the Government of Australia and the Government of Japan for the Protection of Migratory Birds and Birds in Danger of Extinction and their Environment" dated 6 February 1974 "Convention on the Conservation of Migratory Species of Wild animals" (Bonn Convention) dated 23 June 1979 and "Agreement Between the Government of Australia and the Government of The People's Republic of China for the Protection of Migratory Birds and their Environment" dated 20 October 1986.
- (b) specified in Schedule 6 that the grounds for making this declaration are that I believe that the species is vulnerable to, or threatened with, extinction.
