Except where a standard form is used, all notices for publication must have a covering instruction setting out requirements. A typewritten original is to be provided. All other copy is to be confined within the margins of: 20mm from the top and bottom and 25mm from left and right hand sides of the page. Copy is to be numbered consecutively and fastened securely together. Dates, proper names and signatures are to be shown clearly.

Copy will be returned unpublished if not submitted in accordance with these requirements.  
(Note: Fax copies will not be accepted).

**CLOSING TIME.** Notices for publication should be lodged with the ACT Gazette Office, Publications and Public Communication, ACT Administration Centre, unless otherwise specified, by 4.30 p.m., Wednesday in the week prior to publication.


### CLINICAL WASTE ACT 1990

#### REVOCATION AND APPOINTMENT
