CONSUMER AFFAIRS ACT 1973

CONSUMER PRODUCT SAFETY ORDER

WHEREAS I am satisfied that the making of a consumer product safety order is reasonable and necessary to prevent or reduce the risk of injury to or the impairment of health, of persons arising out of the possession, handling or use of those goods by those persons.

I, TERENCE CONNOLLY, Attorney General, pursuant to section 15FC of the Consumer Affairs Act 1973, make a consumer product safety order that the supply of the goods in the Schedule be prohibited in the Australian Capital Territory.

THE SCHEDULE

Goods being devices designed or intended to bodily restrain an infant or child in a cot or bed, including but not limited to goods known as "Baby Safe Cot or Bed Restraint", "Sleepsafe Suit", "Zewi Safety Cover" and "Johnco Safety Sleep".


