



Plan No. 1: Part of Taronga Place in the Division of O'Malley in the District of Woden Valley.


Plan No. 2: Part of the road known as Sutton Road in the District of Kowen.




This is Plan Number One annexed to Instrument No. 36/92 signed on this 2nd day of December, 1992.






This is Plan Number Two annexed to Instrument No. 36/92 signed on this 2 nd day of December, 1992.


Under Section 217A of the Motor Traffic Act 1936, I REVOKE all previous determinations of fees so far as they are payable for the purposes of Section 163C(2) of the Act and relate to the car parks specified in the Schedule; and

I DETERMINE that the fee for the issue of a parking voucher from a voucher machine located at a site specified in the Schedule shall be the amount specified in the Schedule in relation to that site.

UNDER Section 163C(3) of the Act, I SPECIFY that, for the purposes of Subsection 163C(2) of the Act, the period in relation to a voucher machine located at a site specified in the Schedule shall be the period specified in the Schedule in relation to that site.
