



WEST BELCONNEN;

BRADDON SECTION 22 BLOCKS 6 - 9;

GRIFFITH SECTION 84 BLOCKS 4 - 7.

Pursuant to Part II Division 3 of the Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991 the ACT Executive has approved four Variations to the Territory Plan relating to:

Gungahlin: Part of Nicholls including the Gold Creek Tourist Area;

West Belconnen;

Braddon Section 22 Blocks 6 - 9; and

Griffith Section 84 Blocks 4 - 7.

The date of commencement of these four Variations is 18 December 1992.
