## Categories used in this Gazette

### **Industrial Machinery and Equipment (19)**

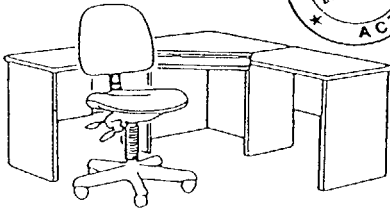
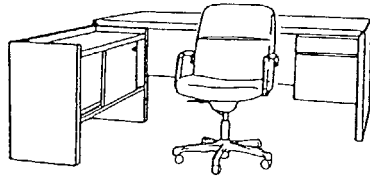

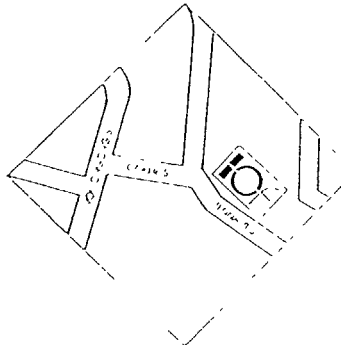
