All other copy is to be confined within the margins of: 20mm from the top and bottom and 25mm from left and right hand sides of the page. **PRIVATE NOTICES.** The rates of charge and conditions applying to acceptance of copy for private notices are as follows:

Remittances must be forwarded with a copy of the notice for publication. Notices received without payment will be returned unpublished.


