DECLARATION OF PRESCRIBED QUALIFICATIONS

I, CATHERINE LOUISE MEAD, Chief Health Officer for the ACT, as delegate for the Minister in pursuance of Subsection 29(3) of the Radiation Act 1983 hereby revoke the declaration of Robert John Scott, Chief Health Officer for the ACT and delegate of the Minister, dated 24 October 1990 and declare on the recommendation of the Radiation Council of the Australian Capital Territory that each of the following qualifications is a prescribed qualification for the purposes of paragraph 29(1)(c) of that Act.
