<i>Design Review</i>	
Design review of boilers or pressure vessels	\$31.00 plus \$62.00 per hour
<i>Issue of a Boiler Attendant's Certificate</i>	
a) issue of boiler attendant's certificate	\$68.00
b) re-issue of certificate	\$32.00
<i>Inspection of Boilers</i>	
1) Locomotive, traction engine or road roller boilers, having a heating surface	
a) not exceeding 7.50 square metres	\$83.00
b) exceeding 7.50 square metres	\$116.00
2) Boilers (other than locomotive, traction engine or road roller boilers) having a heating surface, including economiser and superheater (if any)	
a) not exceeding 2 square metres	\$32.00
b) exceeding 2 square metres but not exceeding 5 square metres	\$52.00
c) exceeding 5 square metres but not exceeding 15 square metres	\$83.00
d) exceeding 15 square metres but not exceeding 70 square metres	\$116.00
e) exceeding 70 square metres but not exceeding 200 square metres	\$149.00
f) exceeding 200 square metres but not exceeding 400 square metres	\$158.00
g) exceeding 400 square metres	\$190.00 plus \$6.00 per 100 square metres or part thereof by which the heating surface exceeds 400 square metres

*Inspection of Pressure Vessels*

- 1) Steam jacketed pan having an internal diameter
  - a) not exceeding 1 metre \$27.00
  - b) exceeding 1 metre \$32.00
- 2) Other pressure vessels having an internal capacity
  - a) not exceeding 150 litres \$27.00
  - b) exceeding 150 litres but not exceeding 1,500 litres \$32.00
  - c) exceeding 1,500 litres but not exceeding 3,000 litres \$52.00
  - d) exceeding 3,000 litres \$74.00

**Other**

*Exempted Vessels*

- 1) For an inspection required to be performed on any vessel eligible for exemption, the fee payable shall be \$190.00

*Single Inspections*

- 1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this paragraph, where in one day in any premises an inspection is made of:
  - a) only one boiler and no pressure vessel, or
  - b) only one pressure vessel and no boiler, and the boiler or pressure vessel inspected is one referred to in Inspection of Boilers subparagraph 2(a) and Inspection of Pressure Vessels subparagraph 1(a) and (b), and 2(a) and (b), the fee to be charged for the inspection shall be 50 percent in excess of the fee otherwise payable

*Multiple Inspections*

- 1) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this paragraph, where in any one day in any premises 5 or more boilers or 5 or more pressure vessels are inspected, the fee to be charged for the inspection shall be 30 percent less than the fees otherwise payable

For the issue of copies of any of the certificates of competency or a certificate as authorised attendants referred to above	\$32.00
<i>Design Review</i>	
Design review of cranes, hoists, lifts, plant, scaffolding and gear	\$32.00 plus \$63.00 per hour
<i>Testing of lifts</i>	\$31.00 plus \$21.00 per hour
Re-testing where initial test has failed inspection	\$500.00 plus \$60.00 per hour
<i>Notification of intention to commence building, excavation or compressed air work</i>
