WEIGHBRIDGE FEES FOR THE DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE

DEFINITIONS

"Household Garbage" means waste from residential premises generated by domestic activity and transported by the householder.

"Industrial and Commercial Garbage" means waste generated, collected, transported or disposed of as part of an industrial or commercial activity. This includes wastes from offices and professional premises.
