ADMINISTRATION ACT 1989

DELEGATION

Under section 5(1) of the Administration Act 1989 I

2. DELEGATE to the person for the time being holding or performing the duties of an office specified in column 1 of the Schedule, my powers under the provisions specified in Column 2 of the Schedule, opposite and in relation to that office.

In this instrument, a reference to a position number is a reference to an office created under the Public Service Act 1922 of the Commonwealth which is located in the branch of the Australian Public Service comprising the Transitional Staff as that term is defined in the ACT Self-Government (Consequential Provisions) Act 1988 of the Commonwealth.

**DIVISION OF BONYTHON: FAMOUS S.A.'s, PARTICULARLY JOURNALISTS,
S.A.'s DISTRICTS.**

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
SALAS STREET	Eugene Salas (1863-1915)	He was a Deaf and Dumb missionary in South Australia. He travelled throughout the state collecting subscriptions for the erection of a church and institute. He visited and instructed the Deaf and Dumb.
TENISON-WOODS CIRCUIT	Mary Cecil Tenison Woods O.B.E. (1896-1971)	Lawyer and Social reformer. She was first woman to graduate in Law from the University of Adelaide in 1917, she was called to the South Australian Bar. She established the first womens law partnership in Australia. She was a member of the Child Welfare Advisory Council she initiated a campaign for the reform of administrative policy and practice in the N.S.W. Child Welfare Dept, 1942. Her work resulted in the S.A. Parliament overhauling it's Children's Court procedures in 1934.



NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
NAMBIR COURT	Dr Gopalan (George) Nambir (1937-1985)	He graduated from Adelaide Medical University in 1964. He spent all professional life attending disabled patients in the Spinal Injuries Centre at Hampstead Centre where he was appointed Director of Spinal Injuries in 1974. He was one of Australia's leading specialists in rehabilitation medicine.
ALFORD PLACE	Henry Alford (b1816)	He arrived in South Australia in 1836. He volunteered for the Police Force in 1838; and later became Inspector. He made three overland trips between Adelaide and Victoria as a gold escort. He was regarded as one of the most active in the capture of bushrangers.

BROOKER STREET	Thomas Henry Brooker (1850-1927)	He arrived in South Australia in 1854; he was employed at Hardy's Bankside Vineyard for 15 years and appointed Manager of New Market East Terrace, Adelaide. He then became Secretary of the Adelaide Fruit and Produce Exchange for 24 years. He was Chairman of the Board of Governors, Botanic Gardens; founder and director W. Torrens Stan Bowkett Building Society. He was the Mayor of Hindmarsh 1891-92.

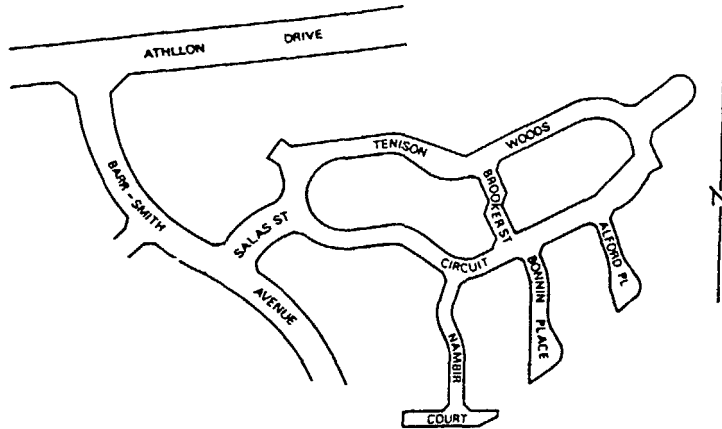

BONNIN PLACE	Dr Mark Bonnin (1912-1991)	He was a distinguished specialist physician at the Royal Adelaide Hospital for more than 30 years. He worked variously as a consultant physician, visiting physician and honorary physician. In 1977 he became emeritus specialist with the hospital. He was an honorary life governor of the Australian Postgraduate Federation in Medicine, a Fellow of the Royal College of Physician and a Fellow of the Royal Australian College of Physicians, from which he received the first college medal for long and outstanding service.







NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
JOWETT COURT	EDMUND JOWETT (1858-1936)	Politician, pastoralist and businessman; arrived Melbourne 1876; on formation of the National Party in 1917 he became Victorian Vice President; deputy leader of the new parliamentary Country Party 1920-1922; acquired pastoral properties mainly in Queensland beginning in 1886 with few in N.S.W. and Victoria. He promoted woollen manufacturing, instituted 'Wool Week', headed a 'Use More Wool' committee; appointed growers representative on the war time Central Wool committee subsequently served in similar capacity on the Commonwealth Bureau of Commerce and Industry and on the Victorian Meat Advisory committee; director of several companies; Australian president, British Immigration League from 1916 and representative in Australia of the Royal Colonial Institute; publications include The unnatural fall in prices due to currency legislation (1895), Electoral reform of Australia (1917) and Proportional representation of the Senate (1919).




