

Categories used in this Gazette

Industrial Machinery and Equipment (19)

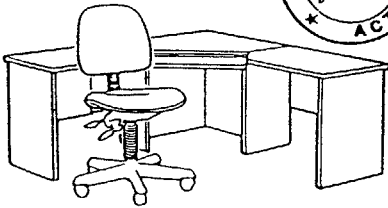
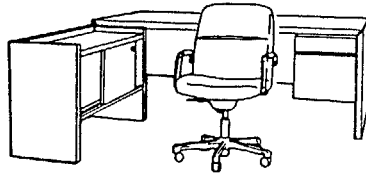

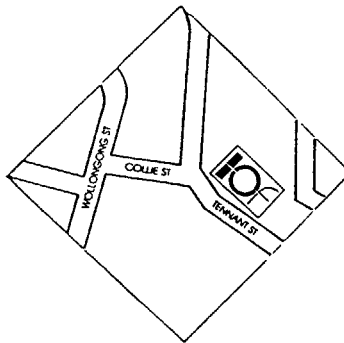
