


FIRE BRIGADE (ADMINISTRATION) ACT 1974

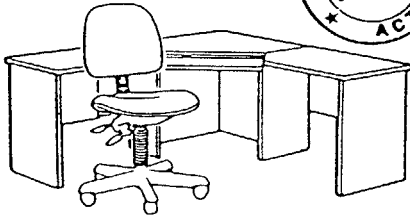
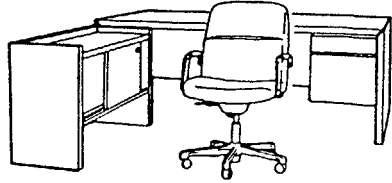

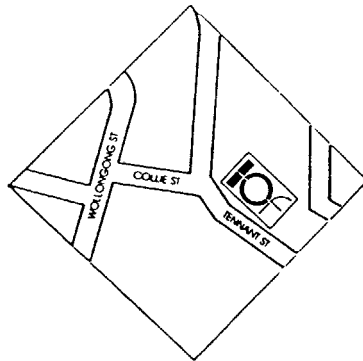
