STANDARD TIME AND SUMMER TIME ACT 1972

DECLARATION

UNDER Section 5A of the Standard Time and Summer Time Act 1972, I DECLARE that the period commencing at the hour of two o'clock in the morning by the mean time of the one hundred and fiftieth meridian of longitude east of Greenwich, England, on Sunday the 30th day of October 1994 and ending at the hour of two o'clock in the morning by the mean time of that meridian on Sunday the 5th day of March 1995 shall be a daylight saving period for the purposes of the Act.
