DRAFT VARIATION NO.33 TO THE TERRITORY PLAN

LAND USE RESTRICTIONS FOR MULTI-UNIT DEVELOPMENT

The ACT Planning Authority is inviting comment on draft Variation No.33 to the Territory Plan which has been prepared following consideration of the recommendations of the Review of Residential Redevelopment Policies conducted by Mr Bob Lansdown AO CBE.

The draft Variation proposes to amend the Residential Land Use Policies in the Territory Plan by prohibiting additional dwellings on single dwelling blocks on previously undeveloped land until 5 years after completion of the original single dwelling.

For applications lodged between 21 August and 21 November 1994, the Executive may authorise departures from these provisions in circumstances of significant hardship or for social justice reasons.

The draft Variation also proposes to prohibit 3 storey redevelopment in the B1 Area north of Wakefield Avenue and west of Northbourne Avenue, except in accordance with a Local Area Plan or Plan adopted by the ACT Planning Authority after appropriate consultation with the community.

This provision will apply to all applications received after 21 August 1994.

Copies of the draft Variation:

This draft Variation is to have interim effect under the provision of section 9 of the Act for the "defined period".

This is proposed to be done as soon as practicable after the closing date, therefore written comments must be received by Tuesday 28 February 1995.
