### Information for the Applicant

#### Am I entitled to apply for a pre-poll vote?

If you are on the ACT electoral roll you are entitled to apply for a pre-poll vote if you expect to be unable to attend a polling place on polling day or your address has been suppressed from the roll.

#### EITHER

#### Mail or fax this application to receive voting material by post.

You can post your application to PO Box 272, Civic Square, ACT 2608 or fax it to the ACT Electoral Commission on (06) 205 0382.

#### OR

#### Vote in person at a pre-poll voting centre.

A written application is not required if you prefer to vote in person, during business hours, at any of the advertised pre-poll voting centres. The location of pre-poll voting centres will be published in local newspapers in the period leading up to polling day or telephone (06) 205 0033 for details.

### Information for the Witness

#### Who can be a witness?

If you are in Australia, this application must be witnessed by an elector whose name appears on a Commonwealth of Australia electoral roll. If you are overseas, any person 18 years of age or older may be a witness. A candidate for election cannot be a witness.

#### Duties of a witness.

As a witness you must –

- be satisfied as to the identity of the applicant;
- see the applicant sign the application,
- be satisfied that the statements contained in the application are true,
- sign the application, add the date and your name and address.
