CASINO CONTROL ACT 1988

APPROVAL

SCHEDULE

This is the accompanying Schedule to the Instrument of Approval under section 72(3) of the Casino Control Act 1988 signed by me J. V. Townsend the Delegate of the Minister on the 25th day of February 1994.

ALTERATION TO THE APPROVED RULES OF THE AUTHORISED GAME OF PAI GOW.

Terms Used in Pai Gow

In addition:

‘Priority Set Marker

A marker used to identify a box where the total amount wagered is equal to or greater than half the box maximum and indicating that those hands must be set prior to any other player commencing the setting or viewing of their tiles.’

Rule 5. Minimum and Maximum Wagers

Revoke 5.1(a) and replace with:

‘5.1(a) the minimum and maximum wagers, per box per table, shall be displayed on a sign at or near the table.’

Revoke 5.5 and replace with:

‘5.5 The casino operator may allow a player to wager in excess of the stated table maximum provided that a marker denoting the new maximum for that box is placed adjacent to that box. No other player shall be permitted to play on that box while a maximum limit marker is in force.’

Rule 7. Wagers

In addition:

‘7.5 Combined box wagers equal to or greater than half the stated table maximum shall be indicated with a priority set marker prior to the tiles being dealt for that round of play.’

Rule 10. Setting of Hands

In addition:

‘10.6 Where the combined wagers on a box or boxes equals or is greater than half the stated box maximum, that box or those boxes shall set their hand prior to any other player commencing the setting or viewing of their tiles.’

‘10.7 Once the hands have been set in accordance with rule 10.6 and placed face down on the layout in two hands, they shall be capped with the priority set marker and shall not be altered until a decision has been rendered and implemented with respect to the wager or wagers on that hand of play.’

Rule 13. Irregularities

In addition:

‘13.10 Where a player is not present to set his/her tiles, the dealer shall set the tiles according to the house way.’
