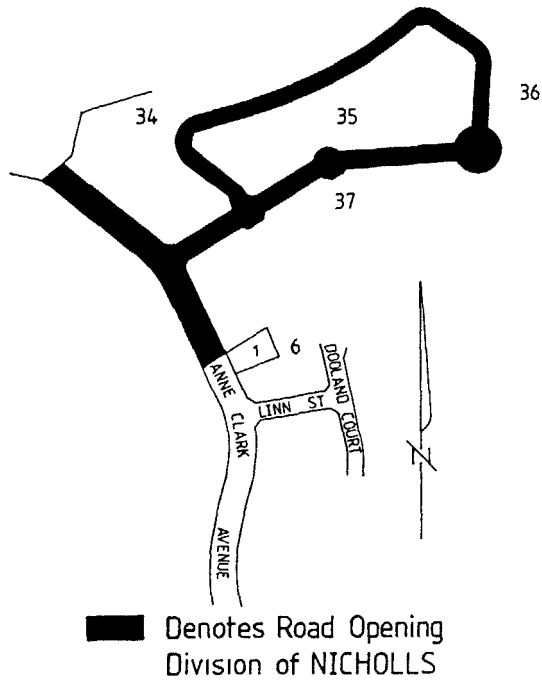
SCHEDULE

Plan No. 2 The roads within Sections 17 to 22 and 24 in the Division of Nicholls in the District of Gungahlin.

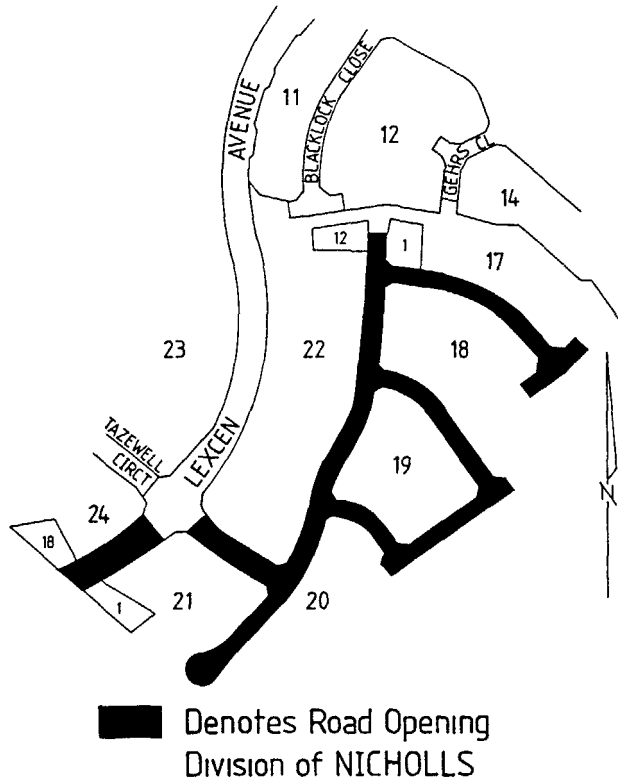
Plan No. 3 The road known as Leahy Close within Section 100 in the District of Narrabundah in the District of Canberra Central.

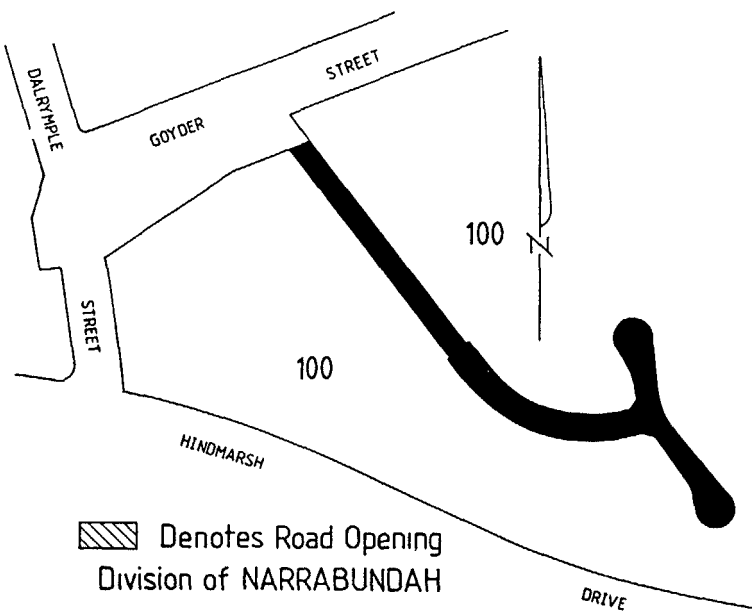
