NOISE CONTROL ACT 1988

EXEMPTION NOTICE

No.002/95

Under Subsection 16(2) of the Noise Control Act 1988, I exempt, **EXHIBITION PARK IN CANBERRA** from the provisions of section 12 of the *Noise Control Act 1988* between the hours of **6:30pm** and **11:00pm** on the **25 JANUARY 1995** in respect of noise emitted from a live music event **Breaking of the Dry Concert** to be conducted at Exhibition Park in Canberra on Flemington Road, Mitchell in the Australian Capital Territory.

Provided that the emitted noise level **shall not exceed background noise levels by greater than 15 dB(A)** at the nearest and/or most affected residence and the concert is conducted in compliance with the conditions set out by the Pollution Control Authority.

Subject to the *Administrative Appeals Tribunal Act 1989*, an application may be made to the Administrative Appeals Tribunal for a review of the decision to which this notice relates.

Except where subsection 26(11) of the *Administrative Appeals Tribunal Act 1989* applies a person whose interests are affected by the decision may request a statement pursuant to Section 26 of the Act.
