PRE-ACQUISITION DECLARATION

The Australian Capital Territory Executive (the 'Executive') is considering the acquisition under the Lands Acquisition Act 1994 (the 'Act') by the Executive of an interest described in Item 1, in the land described in Item 2 for the public purpose described in Item 3.

1. The Interest

The interest being considered for acquisition is the unexpired residue of the Crown Lease Volume 1115 Folio 48 in respect of the land.

2. The Land:

The land is the area of approximately 78 square metres being part of Block 4 Section 55 Division of Fyshwick and being the shaded area on the sketch attached to this notice.

3. The Public Purpose

The public purpose is for a public road.

4. Particulars of the use to which the land will be put or for which it will be developed:

The land is to be used as part of a road system known as the Monaro Highway.

5. Reasons why the land appears to be suitable for that use or for development for that use:

The land appears to be suitable as it is adjoining the road known as the Monaro Highway (Dairy Road). This will allow for the future expansion of the said road.

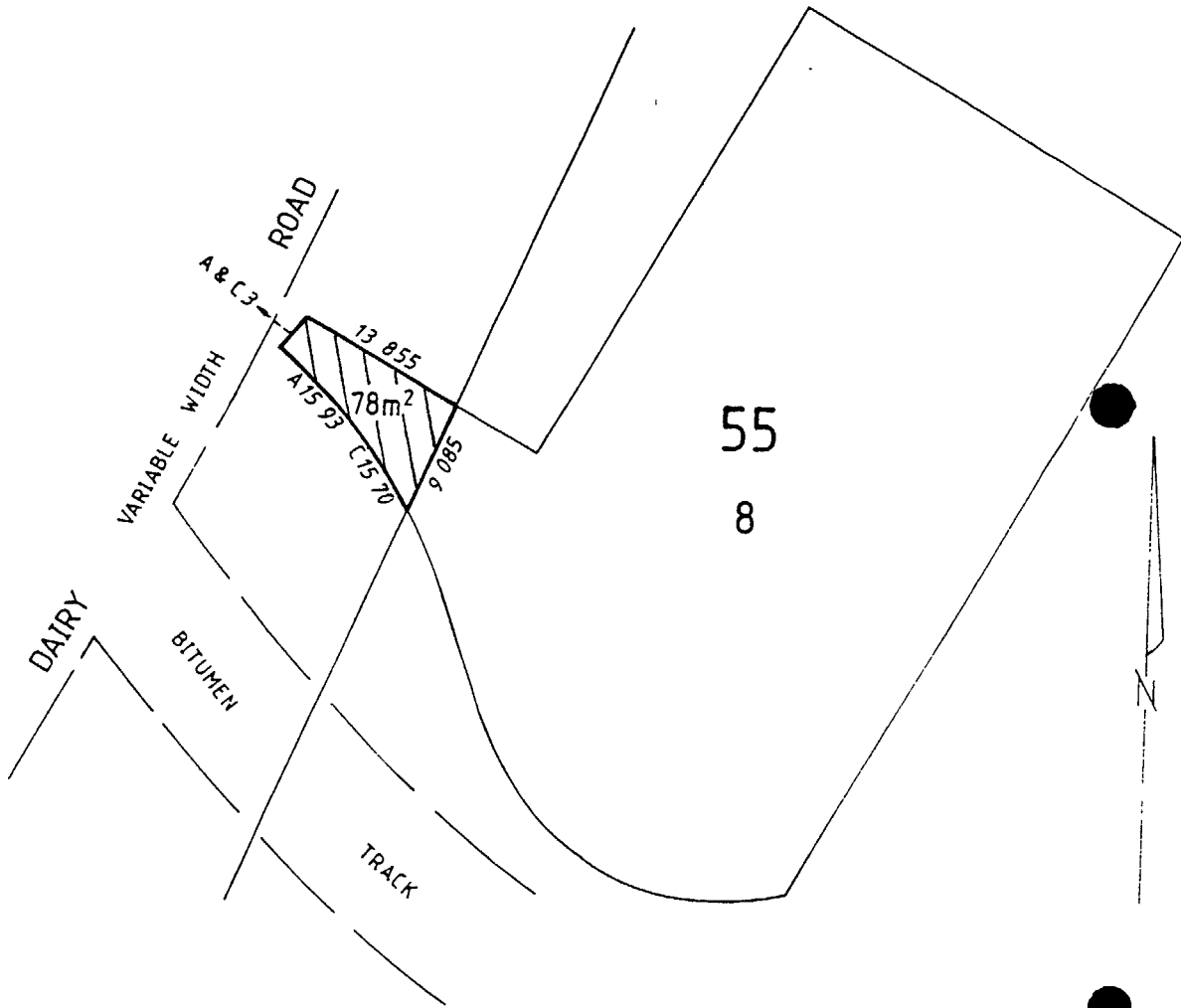
