



Expressions of Interest Smoke-free Areas Act Inspectors Register

The Smoke-free Areas (Enclosed Public Places) Act 1994 prohibits smoking in a wide range of enclosed public places throughout the ACT. Commencing 6 December 1995, restaurants which meet specified criteria, including compliance with AS1668 2–1991, may be granted conditional exemptions from the general smoking prohibition.

Expressions of interest are invited from suitably qualified building services engineers interested in carrying out technical inspections pursuant to the Act. Inspections will occur on an irregular basis and are likely to involve technical assessments of compliance with exemption conditions, including inspection of equipment, maintenance and operational records and measurements of outdoor airflow rates

Your expression of interest should include: the names, experience and qualifications of engineers who would provide inspection services (minimum NPER 2—Mechanical), capacity to provide services, type of available monitoring equipment, cost/hr, potential conflicts of interest, and details of Directors or Partners of companies or organisations.
