INVITATION TO COMMENT ON IMPLEMENTATION PLAN NO.17 FOR THE PROPOSED FORECOURT UPGRADING OF MARGARET TIMPSON PARK BELCONNEN

ACT Public Works has submitted to the ACT Planning Authority an Implementation Plan for the proposed Forecourt upgrading of Margaret Timpson Park, Belconnen.

The proposed work involves landscape development and improvement works in the section of the park fronting Benjamin Way including:

- Earthworks and the shaping of two grassed "pyramidal" mounds as a park feature;
- Grassing, turfing, and tree planting;
- Segmental paving, including internal connecting pathway inside the park parallel to Benjamin Way and replacement of existing concrete paving on the Benjamin Way verge;
- Additional park lighting;
- Concreting, including mowing strips, concrete hips and apex on grassed "pyramids" and concrete retaining wall;

- · Subsoil drainage;
- · Irrigation of grassed areas;
- Painting of existing pergola structures and lighting columns; and
- Granite gravel surface treatment under existing "Flugelman Cubes" sculpture.

It is proposed that the construction will commence in late July or August 1995, and will cost approximately \$190,000.
