INVITATION TO COMMENT ON IMPLEMENTATION PLAN NO.18 FOR THE MONASH AIR MONITORING AND WEATHER STATION

ACT Public Works has submitted to the ACT Planning Authority an Implementation Plan for the Monash Air Monitoring and Weather Station. This is proposed to be located in an area between the Goodwin Retirement Village and the future club site and playing fields located at the intersection of Isabella Drive and Cockcroft Avenue, Monash.

The proposed work involves:

- the construction of a single storey weather station building with a 10 metre high tapered steel anemometer tower;
- the location of a transportable shed for an air monitoring station;
- the construction of an access easement from Cockcroft Avenue;
- the construction of a 2.4 metre high black chain mesh security fence around both buildings; and
- the removal of some shrubs and the planting of screen shrubs.
