CANCELLATION OF REGISTRATION OF A POLITICAL PARTY — SMOKERS ARE VOTERS AND CIVIL RIGHTS

Pursuant to section 247 of the *Electoral Act 1992*, on 30 August 1995 the ACT Electoral Commission:

- set aside the decision of the Deputy Electoral Commissioner of 11 January 1995 to register Smokers Are Voters and Civil Rights as an eligible political party; and
- substituted its own decision to refuse the application submitted on 21 December 1994 for registration of *Smokers Are Voters and Civil Rights* as an eligible political party.

The party's details have accordingly been removed from the ACT Register of Political Parties.
