

All other copy is to be confined within the margins of: 20mm from the top and bottom and 25mm from left and right hand sides of the page. The Aged and Disability Purchasing and Development Section, Department of Health and Community Care, is seeking tenders from organisations to provide a range of Respite Support Services and a Continuity of Care service.

Tender No 1 RESPITE SUPPORT SERVICES

The Respite Support Services will develop a range of approaches which will provide greater resources for support, encourage services to focus on individual needs and preferences, encourage more flexible support, and assist clients to participate in making decisions about the support they receive. These approaches will seek to provide innovative solutions to identified needs.
