The project consists of three sub-projects: Civil Construction and Maintenance, Public Administration, and Fire. Nature of Services:

The National Transition Program is designed to develop new courses and translate existing apprenticeships, traineeships and other vocational education and training courses to Australian Vocational Training System (AVTS) principles.
