

All other copy is to be confined within the margins of: 20mm from the top and bottom and 25mm from left and right hand sides of the page. Computers and peripherals (purchase and lease); electronic office machines (see also Code 16); satellites; radio and television transmitting equipment; television cameras; picture tubes and studio equipment; navigational aids; semi-conductors; telephones and switch-boards; X-ray equipment; printed circuit boards

Industrial Machinery and Equipment (19)

Agricultural and industrial machinery; material handling equipment; machine tools, saw blades, verner calipers, jigs, dies; commercial heaters and coolers; outboard motors, mechanical typewriters

Leather, Rubber, Plastic and Manufactured Good NEC (20)

Consultancy, Property and Business Services NEC (27)

Research in the agricultural biological, physical and social sciences; meteorological services

Community Services, Recreational, Personal and Other Services (31)

Police; prisons; fire brigades; garbage disposal; film production; hotel and catering services
