INVITATION TO COMMENT ON IMPLEMENTATION PLAN NO.32 FOR GUNGAHLIN DRIVE CONNECTION TO THE BARTON HIGHWAY

Construction and Maintenance Management Service, of the Department of Urban Services, is proposing the construction of the Gungahlin Drive connection to the Barton Highway.

The works proposed include the construction of:

- approximately 3km of the first of the two carriageways for the arterial road linking the
 existing part of Gungahlin Drive with the Barton Highway (including intersections with
 connecting roads);
- extension of Sandford Street, Wells Station Drive (between Gungahlin Drive and Hoskins Street) and Hoskins Street extension including into the cemetery and crematorium;
- embankments for future carriageways;
- · landscaping within the road reserves including formation of cycleways; and
- cycleway connection from the existing cycleway near Palmerston to Mitchell along Wells Station Road.

It is proposed that this project will be constructed within the next five years.
