INVITATION TO COMMENT ON IMPLEMENTATION PLAN NO.36 FOR PALMERSTON LANE, MANUKA

The Planning and Land Management Group, of the Department of Urban Services, is proposing an Implementation Plan to identify the scope of works necessary to improve the pedestrian and trading environment for Palmerston Lane, Manuka.

The proposal identifies

- upgrading works to the pavement, street furniture, lighting, waste management and services.
- the most appropriate means by which individual property redevelopment will contribute to an improved pedestrian environment,
- design means for discourage street crime and to increase community perceptions of safety;
- suitable shopfront treatments which provide active and lively frontages while maintaining service access to individual properties;
- opportunities for public art components which complement and enhance Manuka's unique characteristics,
- mechanisms for maintaining and enhancing disabled access to all areas and facilities, and
- innovative short and long term strategies to deal with waste management for the lane, in particular with regard to waste minimisation and the maximising of recycling processes.
