AUTHORISED GAME OF AMERICAN ROULETTE**

**AMERICAN ROULETTE INDEX**

**Insert** the following in the index list after the reference to Diagram "D"

"Diagram "E" ..... 4A"

**Insert** the diagram of the American Roulette table cloth marked as 'Diagram "E"' after the diagram marked 'Diagram "D"'



## **TERMS USED IN AMERICAN ROULETTE**

**Insert the following after the reference and explanation of "Race Track":**

### **"Asian Race Track**

**The Asian race track shall have twelve sections to facilitate the placing of bets for specific combinations of numbers."**

## **1. AMERICAN ROULETTE LAYOUT, WHEEL AND BALL**

**Delete existing rule 1.1**

**Insert the following:**

**"1.1 The American Roulette table shall be of the American type with the cloth marked in a manner similar to that in Diagram "B", "C", "D" or "E."**

## **5. WAGERS**

**Delete existing rule 5.3**

**Insert the following:**

### **"5.3 Race Track**

**Where a race track system for accepting multiple piece place bets is used, this wager called by a player must be accompanied by chips, or cash which shall be immediately converted into chips, and placed on the layout, or on the appropriate area of the race track before "NO MORE BETS" is called.**

- (i) Wagers defined on the race track which utilises the cloth marked in accordance with Diagram "D" are:**
  - (a) Serie 5/8 - Tier (six piece wager):  
5/8, 10/11, 13/16, 23/24, 27/30 and 33/36;**

- (b) Orphelins (five piece wager):  
1, 6/9, 14/17, 17/20 and 31/34;
  - (c) Serie 0/2/3 - Voisins de Zero (nine piece wager):  
0/2/3, 4/7, 12/15, 18/21, 19/22, 25/26/28/29 and 32/35;
  - (d) O-Spel - Zero Game (four piece wager):  
0/3, 12/15, 26 and 32/35; and
  - (e) Voisins - Neighbours (five piece wager):  
a specific number with two neighbouring numbers either side,  
eg. 17 and the neighbours = 2, 25, 17, 34 and 6.
- (ii) Wagers defined on the Asian race track which utilises the cloth marked in accordance with Diagram "E" are:
- (a) Horse (three piece wager):  
32, 15, 19;
  - (b) Snake (three piece wager):  
4, 21, 2;
  - (c) Dragon (three piece wager):  
25, 17, 34;
  - (d) Rabbit (three piece wager):  
6, 27, 13;
  - (e) Tiger (three piece wager):  
36, 11, 30;
  - (f) Ox (three piece wager):  
8, 23, 10;
  - (g) Rat (three piece wager):  
16, 24, 5;
  - (h) Boar (three piece wager):  
20, 1, 33;

- (i) Dog (three piece wager):  
9, 31, 14;
- (j) Rooster (three piece wager):  
29, 18, 22;
- (k) Monkey (three piece wager):  
12, 28, 7; and
- (l) Ram (three piece wager):  
26, 3, 35."

## **6. AMERICAN ROULETTE - PAYOUT ODDS**

**Delete existing rule 6.2**

**Insert the following:**

"6.2 When the result is zero:

- (a) wagers placed on zero or on a combination of zero with 1, 2 or 3 shall win and be paid at the odds in accordance with rule 6.1; and
- (b) all other wagers shall lose."

## **9. GENERAL PROVISIONS**

**Delete existing rule 9.14**

**Insert the following:**

"9.14 Rule 9.13 does not preclude a player from touching winning outside wagers (i.e. winning wagers on the even chances, column or dozen) after those wagers have been fully paid."
