

Computer, Office Equipment and Electrical Equipment NEC (18)

Computers and peripherals (purchase and lease); electronic office machines (see also Code 16), satellites, radio and television transmitting equipment; television cameras; picture tubes and studio equipment, navigational aids; semi-conductors; telephones and switch-boards, X-ray equipment, printed circuit boards

Industrial Machinery and Equipment (19)

Reminder Notice to Suppliers Prequalification on ACT Government Construction Industry Projects

As previously announced by the Government in October 1996, a revised Prequalification/Quality Assurance program is being progressively implemented on ACT Government construction industry projects.

Since 1 January 1997 Preliminary Second Party Quality Assurance Certification has been a requirement for prequalification for building and construction related contracts, including trade package contracts over \$500,000

From 1 July 1997, Substantial Second Party Quality Assurance Certification will be required for prequalification for building and construction related contracts, including trade package contracts over \$500,000 and also for consultancies and project/construction/works management engagements on projects over \$50,000 and studies with a fee value over \$10,000

Current prequalification will require upgrading at the next renewal date after 1 July 1997 The upgrade involves auditing against additional elements of the AS 9000 series Quality Standards and demonstrated use of the quality system in place

From 1 October 1997, Preliminary Second Party Quality Assurance Certification will be required for building and construction related contracts, including trade package contracts between \$100,000 and \$500,000
