How to apply to the ACT Administrative Appeals Tribunal – Write within 28 days explaining the details of the decision and the reasons for asking for a review.

Cost – To lodge an application there is a fee of \$134.00. You may apply to have the fee waived on the grounds of hardship. No fee is payable if you are receiving legal assistance.
