ACT GOVERNMENT PLANNING AND LAND MANAGEMENT GROUP

DRAFT VARIATION NO.81 TO THE TERRITORY PLAN - MONARO HIGHWAY REALIGNMENT

The Planning and Land Management Group (PALM) of the Department of Urban Services (incorporating the ACT Planning Authority) is proposing a draft Variation to the Territory Plan which, if adopted, would:

- amend the Territory Plan Map to allow for the realignment of the gazetted route for the Monaro Highway between Royalla Siding and Williamsdale in the ACT; and
- make some minor corrections to the Written Statement in the provisions for roads outside urban areas.

This draft Variation is to have interim effect under the provision of section 9 of the Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991 for the "defined period"
